DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What personal qualities did Dorothy Vaughan, Mary Jackson, and Katherine Johnson possess that helped them succeed? What personal sacrifices did they have to make to work at NASA?
- How did Dorothy, Mary, and Katherine's willingness to continually learn, educate, and train themselves beyond the scope of their immediate jobs contribute to their success?
- What do you think about Mary's belief that "achievement worked like a bank account. It was something you drew on when you were in need and made deposits to when you had a surplus."? (p. 158)
- The power of imagination and self-belief contributed to Dorothy, Mary, and Katherine's success. Why is it important to imagine possibilities for yourself?



ACTIVITIES

 At the Langley Memorial Aeronautical Laboratory, one of the prime objectives was to build a faster, more advanced spacecraft through testing. Build a paper airplane, then form hypotheses, conduct tests, and form conclusions. Use the information you learn to modify your design and build a more advanced paper airplane.


