DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What excites Lucy and Fred about their field guide? What is their common interest? Do you have friends with similar interests? What project might you do together?
- How does Lucy feel after her friend's death? How is this grief similar to losing her mother 5 years earlier. Have you ever lost someone close to you? Describe what it felt like?
- Who are the people in Lucy's life who help her after her friend's death?
 Who are the people in your life who help you when you're sad?
- Does Lucy really think Fred can read her postcards? If so, how? If not, why does she write them?




ACTIVITIES

- Throughout the book, Lucy and Fred are working on a field guide of their local area. They gather research, information, and illustrations about animals they find in their community. Pick a few animals in your community and create a field guide to describe them.
- Write a newspaper article describing the change in population of great white sharks to the Rockport community. Be sure to explain why and how the population is changing. Add in a mock interview with one of the characters to gather more information.
